What to Prepare

- Please be prepared to share up to two tracks or recordings that showcase your music production skills and experience so far.
- Be ready to share and discuss your work during the interview, including the creative and technical processes you used.
- Your tracks, along with your responses to interview questions, will help us assess your suitability for the course.

What to Expect

- The interview is also a chance for you to ask questions about the course and life at Leeds Conservatoire.
- If we need more information after your interview, we may ask you to submit additional materials.

Applying for Multiple Routes?

If you've applied for both Electronic Music Production and Music Production, you'll only need to attend one interview. We'll use it to assess your fit for all routes.
